Established in 2007, the Centre for Indigenous Studies aims to be the premier hub in Fiji for the teaching, study and promotion of Fijian Language, Literature, Arts and Culture, as well as the study and research into indigenous Fijian society, economy and politics.

The University wishes to appoint a Fellow who can co-ordinate and direct the activities of the Centre in the areas of research into Fijian language and culture, Fijian literature, oral traditions and translations.

Candidates for this position must have: postgraduate qualifications in the Humanities/Arts, intimate knowledge of the Fijian language and culture, proven ability to direct research projects, experience in translating English texts into Fijian, and the ability to present workshops and seminars to groups of adults.

The appointee will be placed on one of the two scales below in line with her/his qualifications and experience :

**Lecturer:** FJD\$34,000 - FJD\$43,000 per annum

**Senior Lecturer:** FJD\$44,000 - FJD\$54,000 per annum

In addition the university pays 8% as superannuation contribution. Appointments are on three year contracts renewable by mutual agreement and subject to satisfactory performance.
