The Department of Education at the University offers three innovative, cutting edge postgraduate programmes namely, a Masters degree in Educational Leadership (MEDUL), a Masters degree in Teaching (MTeach) for experienced educators, and a one-year, full-time, Postgraduate Diploma in Teaching (PGDT) for graduates who intend to teach in secondary schools.

Applications are invited from dynamic and creative individuals who want to join a team of senior educators in teaching, research and outreach activities.

Applicants must have a good Bachelor's degree, qualified teacher status (QTS), postgraduate qualifications in Education, successful teaching experience at the tertiary/pre-tertiary levels, good communication, networking and management skills, and proficiency in the use of ICTs for teaching and learning. Applicants should also be able to demonstrate the capacity to work as part of a progressive team, the ability to contribute to the development of courses and programmes and show a commitment to innovative teaching and learning practices.

Preference will be given to applicants with a satisfactory publications record, experience in distance and flexible learning, work experience in developing countries and a sound understanding of educational leadership and change.

The appointee will be expected to contribute to all the programmes offered by the Department, and must be prepared to teach intensive courses and supervise students in different parts of Fiji.

**The salary range for the above position is:**

**Assistant Lecturer: F\$25,000 – \$33,000 per annum**  
**Lecturer: F\$34,000 – \$43,000 per annum**

Appointment is initially on a three year contract, renewable for a further three years subject to satisfactory performance.

In addition to the salary, the University pays 8% of salary towards superannuation.

The University also provides those appointed from overseas airfares for the appointee and spouse and up to two children who are not yet 18 years of age, a baggage allowance as assistance towards removal cost of personal effects and which may be claimed on the production of receipts, a settling-in allowance on arrival to assist the appointee with temporary accommodation while he or she looks for more permanent accommodation. These benefits may also apply to Fiji based appointees. There are conditions attached to these benefits. Candidates with exceptional attributes may be granted an appropriate salary loading.

Applicants must send their full curriculum vitae, certified copies of their academic qualifications and academic transcript as part of their application and address the criteria for the position they are applying for.
