- i. Passed Fiji Year 13 Examination with an aggregate of at least 200 marks in 4 subjects with a minimum of 50% in English.
- b) Mature entry
- i. Obtained the appropriate University Foundation Certificate; or
- ii. Passed an examination deemed by the University to be equivalent to the University Foundation Education certificate.

Duration of the programme: Full-time-2 Years Part-time -4 Years
